

#1 - #14 SINGLE MODE. #15 - #29 DUAL MODE

The mobile application, Voice Tango "App", is a voice changer app that may also enable the camera during a recording session at the user's discretion. Using both pre-set voice masks or customized voice masks and video camera footage, the user will be able to change the sound of their voice and upload their session to a variety social media platforms, devices and other forms of messaging services for entertainment purposes only.

With the introduction of artificial intelligence "A.I." technology, the available data resources of voice masks should be plentiful in providing the user capability to sound like other individuals of different genders, theatre/ broadcasting professions, celebrities, cartoon and comic book super heroes, animals, and people of strong dialect and accent from selected regions of the world.

The below information supplements the file folder sent over the Summer season, which purpose was to supplement or update the initial framework before staff changes had occurred. In an attempt to avoid further complications this is not an exhaustive definition of protocol to the app, yet more of an itemized list of instruction and detail to correlate to the frame sent months ago. Please bring the frame into view on you computer or device as you read the next set of instruction.

1. Home Screen. User taps the Single Mode icon to begin.
2. Voice Changer List. Displays available voice changer masks. User will either choose a voice mask pre-installed into the app or a voice mask the user had created previously, (using the advanced sound editor).
3. Voice Selected Features Light Up. User selects a single voice mask and the matching icon displays in the top-center area. The camera icon lights up to be enabled, (Yes/No prompt).
4. Voice Tango Button Lights Up. All conditions have been met and the Voice Tango button flashes. Tap the Voice Tango button/ icon to start the session. The mic is enabled and the app is in a listening mode for the user's voice. The camera is enabled or disabled according to the conditions met.
5. (Optional Cam) And Mic Enabled. A session is currently active. User is speaking, this example shows the front-facing camera capturing and recording video. A traditional recording symbol is displayed to indicate its active status. An audio sound wavelength effect is displayed at the top. The back button located on the top left takes user back to the voice changer list to update his/her voice mask preference.
6. Tap To Restart Session. Tap icon to restart session with the same conditions met. Follow the Yes/No prompt > Press Voice Tango Button to begin a session.
7. Go To Replay Screen - 1. Tap icon to save. User accepts the active session and will begin to modify and edit if necessary.
8. Replay Screen. An audio replay graphic is displayed up top, user can drag to any desired point of the recently finished session. There are also replay controls on the left side of the voice tango button that the user may use... no action takes place if the voice tango button is tapped on this screen. A slide-able voice changer list is visible and allows the user to alternate voice/masks during active replays. On the replay screen the enabled camera footage is either visible or blacked out. The Advanced Sound Editor button and Trim button provides further editing capability. User will tap the Save or Send buttons when the session is satisfactory.
9. Advanced Sound Editor. The features and controls from [8 Replay Screen] are still available here. The Advanced Sound Editor provides in-depth adjustments. The customized voice mask option is created and saved here! The user may choose to add this newly customized voice mask to the voice changer list.
10. Trim Screen. The user may shorten the length of the session at the beginning, ending or on both ends to the user's preference. The enabled camera footage is either visible or blacked out.
11. Discard Trim Edits. The user may have preferred the original length of the session or may have made an erroneous adjustment, tap the icon to discard changes and keep the original content of the session.
12. Go To Replay Screen - 2. User confirms the trimmed content and is taken back to [7. Go To Replay Screen - 1]. User will tap the Save or Send buttons when the session is satisfactory.
13. Save To My Works. Tap to save to a file system/ device folder.
14. Send To. Tap to send session to various destinations such as the Apple Drawer, text messaging, social media platforms, emails and other Share options.

15. Home Screen (Dual Mode). User taps the Dual Mode icon to begin.
16. Voice Changer List Screen. Displays available voice changer masks. User will either choose a voice mask pre-installed into the app or a voice mask the user had created previously, (using the advanced sound editor).
17. Voice Changer Selection 1. User selects first voice mask and the matching icon displays in the top-center area.
18. Voice Changer Selection 2. User selects second voice mask and the matching icon displays in the top-center area. The camera icon lights up to be enabled, (Yes/No prompt). The timer icon lights up to be enabled, (Yes/No prompt), which toggles voice changer selections 1 and 2. Confirm the voice mask timer intervals.
19. Press Flashing Button. All conditions have been met and the Voice Tango button flashes. Tap the Voice Tango button/ icon to start the session. The mic is enabled and the app is in a listening mode for the user's voice. The camera is enabled or disabled according to the conditions met. The timer has been set accordingly.
20. Dual Mode Recording. A session is currently active. Users are speaking, this example shows the front-facing camera capturing and recording video. A traditional recording symbol is displayed to indicate its active status. An audio sound wavelength effect is displayed at the top for voice changers 1 and 2. The timer toggles the active use of voice changer 1 or 2 during a session... voice changer 1 and 2 cannot be used at the same exact time, hence the toggle. The back button located on the top left takes user back to the voice changer list to update his/her voice mask preference. Please note, the voice tango button can manually toggle voice changers 1 and 2 during a session.
21. Tap to Restart Session. Tap icon to restart session with the same conditions met. Follow the Yes/No prompt > Press Voice Tango Button to begin a session.
22. Go To Replay Screen. Tap icon to save. User accepts the active session and will begin to modify and edit if necessary.
23. Replay Screen. An audio replay graphic of both users is displayed up top, user can drag to any desired point of the recently finished session. There are also replay controls on the left side of the voice tango button that the user may use... no action takes place if the voice tango button is tapped on this screen. A slide-able voice changer list is visible and allows the user to alternate voice/masks during active replays. On the replay screen the enabled camera footage is either visible or blacked out. The Advanced Sound Editor button and Trim button provides further editing capability. User will tap the Save or Send buttons when the session is satisfactory.
24. Advanced Sound Editor. The features and controls from [23. Replay Screen] are still available here. The Advanced Sound Editor provides in-depth adjustments. The customized voice mask option is created and saved here! The user may choose to add this newly customized voice mask to the voice changer list.
25. Trim Screen Selected. The user may shorten the length of the session at the beginning, ending or on both ends to the user's preference. The enabled camera footage is either visible or blacked out.
26. Discard Trim Edits. The user may have preferred the original length of the session or may have made an erroneous adjustment, tap the icon to discard changes and keep the original content of the session.
27. Go To Replay Screen. User confirms the trimmed content and is taken back to [23. Go To Replay Screen]. User will tap the Save or Send buttons when the session is satisfactory.
28. Save To My Works. Tap to save to a file system/ device folder.
29. Send To. Tap to send session to various destinations such as the Apple Drawer, text messaging, social media platforms, emails and other Share options.
30. My Works Screen. File system of app allowing user to access and update previous works..
31. Menu Screen. Menu features, settings and location to Unlock App for use of all features without interfering ads.
32. Unlock Screen / Unlock Pop Up box. This appears prompts user to unlock app. If user declines to unlock the app, this message alongside ads will continue to iterate and appear.
